

### Value-for-money of your present course





Value-for-money – by domicile (good or very good value)







### Rating of how teaching staff provide assessment




### Rating of teaching staff



#### Hours per week spent in different class sizes








# Unfortunately, student wellbeing remains below that of the general population. Concerns around the future may be a factor in this.


